

Mrs. Lorena DI GALANTE is Dirigente Superiore\* of the State Police.

In the course of her career, she has held positions at the Police Headquarters of Milan, Rome and Trento. In Trento she held the office of Vicario del Questore (Vice Head of the State Police Provincial Headquarters).

Within the Department of Public Security, she was assigned to the Central Anti-Crime Directorate, where she also held the office of Deputy Director of the S.C.O. (Central Operations Service).

After her promotion to Dirigente Superiore, she was assigned to the Department of Public Security, Anti-Mafia Investigative Directorate as Head of the II Judicial Investigations Branch. This Branch is responsible for planning, scheduling and monitoring the judicial police investigations falling within the DIA's competences and for managing the operations in a coordinated manner with the DIA's central and peripheral offices, forming the Judicial Police Service s under the direction of the National Prosecutor Anti-Mafia and Anti-Terrorism.

Currently, she is assisting the Director in managing the DIA's operational activity and acts as a liaison - in the areas of competence - between the DIA's central branches and offices and the DIA's Field Offices.

She is Project Leader of the @ON Network, a European Union project set up with the aim of strengthening transnational police cooperation, facilitating the deployment of specialised investigators in all Member States to assist in investigations into cross-border organised crime groups.

She has held numerous teaching assignments in various State Police Training Institutes throughout the country, at the Police Academy in Rome, at the Institute for Inspectors of the State Police in Nettuno (RM), at the International School of Higher Education for the Prevention and Countering Organised Crime in Caserta.

By decree of the Chief of Police, she was appointed President of the Equal Opportunities Committee of the Department of Public Security.
